

education, nursing, graphic design, leather and fashion, and of course law and business. The teaching quality of Northampton by government exercise in 2017 ranked us Gold which is the best top-quality teaching in United Kingdom universities."

Academic Partnerships at the University of Northampton, was pleased to announce that from September, students will be able to apply and enrol in face-to-face teaching. 
WINS MEN'S **BASKETBALL** QUARTER FINAL **RGANISED BY**

DR. ALJAZ FATIMA MEMORIAL LECTURE SERIES

Ziauddin University launched Dr. Aijaz Fatima Lecture series which will take place quarterly every year. This lecture series is a tribute to Dr. Aijaz Fatima the founder of Dr. Ziauddin Hospital. The first session in this series was held on January 13, 2022 and the title of the event was Common Psychiatric Ailments.

The event started with the brief unique history of founder of Dr. Ziauddin Hospital, Dr. Aijaz Fatima with the audience by Professor Dr. Rubina Hussain.

While shedding light on disorders and mental health illnesses during a lecture titled "Common Psychiatric Ailments", Dr. Afzal Siddiqui, Consultant Psychiatrist at Camden Primary Care (part of Mental Health Network in London) highlighted that "depression and mood fluctuations, which can be mild, moderate, or severe, are the most frequent disorders. Psychotic disorders can lead to suicide, decreased social engagement, and

overthinking, all of which can alter a person's behaviour and lead to self-harm. There are many other diseases, such as eating disorders and addictions to substances like alcohol or



cannabis, for which basic care therapies are offered in primary care."

Discussing the need for perinatal mental health services, Dr. Pia Ghosh, Consultant Perinatal Psychiatrist at Barnet Hospital & North West London Trust said, "Perinatal mental illness affects 10-20% of new mothers. I believe prevention is a better cure not just for you but for the child and the future generation. The other reason why we need a perinatal psychiatrist is the

need a perinatal psychiatrist is the poor provision of service to this community."

Explaining postnatal depression which is experienced by many parents after having a baby, Dr. Ghosh said that "it is important to seek help as soon as possible if you think you might be depressed, as your symptoms could last months or get worse and have a significant impact on you, your baby, and your family. In severe depression, the risk of relapse is 26% in those who

continued taking their medication and 68% in those who stopped their medication. Maintaining a healthy lifestyle and having someone you can talk to or turn to for support are two things you can do to help you stay healthy".

ZU AT TCF EVENT **'HERO SPEAKER'**

Dr. Adnan Zaib faculty of FEMNS, in-charge administration and alumni of The Citizen Foundation (TCF), a well-known educational institute promoting education in Pakistan, participated in an event on education as a "Hero Speaker". The event was held at TCF School, KoiBrohi Goth, Malir Karachi on Saturday January 29 2022.

During his testimony, he shared his experiences relating to education and community services and the role of Ziauddin University in the education (primary to university level) and health sector.

1 1™ INTERACTIVE SERIES OF ZU DIALOGUES "CYBERCRIME: A DIGITAL THREAT"

The PR & Communications Department of Ziauddin University hosted its 11th ZU Dialogue on Cybercrime: A Digital Threat on February 21st, 2022. The session was moderated by Mr. Amir Shehzad convener ZU Dialogues.

Ms. Nighat Dad, Executive Director, Digital Rights Foundation, shared her views as an expert at the "11th Interactive Series of ZU Dialogues" to discuss the extremely serious situation of cybercrimes increasing in Pakistan and said, "Social media has been more significant than ever in the last year, and cybercrime occurred all around the world during COVID-19, as individuals became overwhelmed with digitization, such as online buying and schooling, using public transit and all contributing to exchanging data online. We don't know if we are secure or not because there is no law for data collection in our country."

During her talk Ms. Nighat Dad disclosed that more than 95,000 cybercrime cases



have been confirmed in the past few years.

She added that people are more into digitalising after COVID-19, and the faster we enter the digitalization era, the

more cybercrimes occur. Lack of understanding, usage or addiction to social media and increasing use of the internet method by those trying to earn money during the COVID-19 pandemic have been identified by cyber experts as some of the causes of the growth in cybercrime. The incidents of social media related cybercrime on Facebook and Instagram are the most common.

Discussing how the threat is growing with the growth of digital technologies, Mr. Muhammad Qasim, Wing Head IT Security, National Bank of Pakistan said "I believe we are living in a prison where we are constantly being watched, monitored, and cracked, not just through our phones but also through other digital footprints that we leave. Pakistan is still not technologically advanced. I believe we should first blame ourselves for not protecting our personal data. It's better to take precautions".

ZIAUDDIN UNIVERSITY HOSTS 4TH ATHENA40 GLOBAL CONVERSATION "WOMEN AS CATALYSTS FOR RESILIENCE, DIVERSITY & CHANGE"

To mark International Women's Day, Ziauddin University in collaboration with Global Thinkers Forum hosted the 4th Athena40 Global Conversation on March 8, 2022, titled "Women as Catalysts for Resilience, Diversity & Change". Speaking at the event, Deputy Head of Mission, British Deputy High Commission Karachi, Mr. Martin Dawson, said, "We must bear in mind that only when there is an investment in women as workers, as leaders, as entrepreneurs and consumers, the whole world benefits. Celebrating a single day is not enough, every day should be women's day".

During the panel discussion, Dr. Masuma Hassan, Chairperson of Pakistan Institutes of International Affairs explained female leadership and said that female leadership does not mean leadership only by high profile personalities who have acquired distinction in politics or public life. It includes women and girls who lead at the community level in crises such as floods and earthquakes, provide

sustenance during droughts, and hold communities together.



As one of the panellists, Ms. Tasneem Ahmar, Executive Director, UKS Research Centre, discussed women's voice and said "be it news, media or entertainment, women's voice, and concerns remain largely missed and underrepresented, even silenced. Thus, depriving our public of getting to know

the real Pakistani women- strong and ambitious, resilient and courageous".

Ms. Sarah Qureshi CEO, Aero Engine Craft (Pvt.) Limited addressed gender equality and said that female leadership is equally important, if not more. There are certain domains where it is far more effective than male leadership as it brings a different perspective to the front altogether.

Mr. Syed Muaz Shah, Director, Centre for Human Rights at Faculty of Law, Politics & Governance, Ziauddin University and moderator of the activity gave a reference to Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah's quote that no nation can rise to the height of glory unless your women are side by side with you. "It is time to recognize the women leaders, who not only lead locally but also internationally through some of the most difficult situations, navigating challenges not witnessed before and sometimes where many men have failed", he further added.
